CIRCUMSTANCES:

According to information obtained from Brooks County Justice of the Peace, Oralia V. Morales these skeletal remains were found at La India Ranch in Falfurrias, Texas. The body is taken to Elizondo's Embalming Services in Mission, Texas.

EXTERNAL EXAMINATION:

The body consists of skeletal remains. He is accompanied by a black cap, blue gray slacks that are torn and full of dirt, and black right tennis shoe. The bones consist of the tarsals and metatarsals within the shoe. There is a skull present that is intact. There is no evidence of injury or fractures seen. The pelvis shows characteristics of a male. The mastoid process also has characteristics of a male. The zygomatic arch also has characteristics of a male. There are teeth missing in the maxilla. The molars have erupted. There are cavities present. The mandible is present and intact. It has characteristics of male. The left pelvic wing bone is present unremarkable and has male characteristics. The left trochanter is intact. This measures 17 ¼ inches. The left tibia is present and intact. This measures 15 inches. The left humerus is present and measures up to 12 ¼ inches. There are no fractures. The left radius measures 9 ¼ inches in greatest dimensions. The left ulna measures up to 10 ½ inches. This is present and appears intact. The right humerus is intact and measures up to 12 ¼ inches. The right radius measures 9 ¼ inches. There is a segment of rib. This is intact and unremarkable. There is a segment of patella and is unremarkable. The metatarsals are present and intact. The set of bones are accompanied by jar of cream and a jar of pills. There is some kind of wallet. The right trochanter measures 17 inches. This is missing the portion of the trochanter head. There are no fractures present. The right fibula measures 12 ¼ inches in greatest dimensions. There is a document present that reads Documento unico de identificacion Republica de El Salvador
